

GoQrides LLC Cookie Website Policy

Effective Date: March 28, 2026

The GoQrides LLC website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive by a website. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. We may use both session cookies (which expire when you close your web browser) and persistent cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Site.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize GoQrides LLC pages or register with GoQrides LLC site or services, a cookie helps GoQrides LLC to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same GoQrides LLC website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the GoQrides LLC features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the GoQrides LLC services or websites you visit.

Types of Cookies We Use

We may use the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** Our website requires the use of these cookies to properly operate or provide necessary functions relating to the services you request. They include cookies that do the following:
 - enabling you to securely log into our website
 - use a shopping cart
 - purchase products
 - “To maintain session integrity, authenticate users, prevent fraudulent activity, support secure transactions between users and third-party businesses, manage user preferences, and ensure the proper functionality and security of the GoQrides platform and GoQPeoples community.”

These are persistent cookies that generally last 12 months. “The purpose of strictly necessary cookies is to enable core functionality of the GoQrides platform, including secure user authentication, maintaining active user sessions, supporting marketplace transactions between

users and third-party businesses, and ensuring the security and proper operation of the GoQrides application and GoQPeoples community.”

- **Analytical/performance cookies.** These cookies allow us and our third-party service providers to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us improve how our website works by, for example, ensuring that users can easily find what they need on our website. These cookies generate aggregate statistics that are not associated with an individualized profile, and are persistent cookies that generally last 12 Months. “The purpose of analytical cookies is to understand how users interact with the platform, track performance, improve user experience, analyze traffic patterns, and measure the effectiveness of advertisements and services offered through the platform.”
- **Functionality cookies.** These cookies enable helpful but non-essential website functions that improve your website experience. By recognizing you when you return to our website, they may, for example, allow us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name, or remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region). These cookies may enable visitor identification over time, but not across different websites. These are persistent cookies that generally last 12 Months. “The purpose of functionality cookies is to remember user preferences, maintain login sessions, personalize the user experience, and support features such as saved settings, user accounts, and interactions within the platform.”
- **Advertising, tracking or targeting cookies.** These cookies enable different advertising related functions. They may allow us to record information about your visit to our website, such as pages visited, links followed, and videos viewed so we can make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. These cookies may enable visitor identification over time, but not across different websites. These are persistent cookies that generally last 12 Months. “The purpose of advertising cookies is to deliver relevant advertisements to users, measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns, track engagement with ads, and support partnerships with businesses that promote their products and services through the platform.”
- **Third-party cookies.** Our website may contain helpful but non-essential features or plugins enabling third party services that use cookies, such as social network connectors, maps, advertising networks, or web traffic analysis services. These cookies may enable visitor identification across websites and over time. These third-party cookies are likely to be analytical cookies, performance cookies or targeting cookies. We do not control the third party's use of those cookies, their duration, or their ability to share information with other third parties. Please review each party's cookie disclosure before consenting to this use category. “The purpose of third-party advertising cookies is to allow external service providers and partners to deliver relevant advertisements, track ad performance, measure engagement, and support advertising services across the platform and, where applicable, across other websites.”
